

Go to the Ibaraki International Association on the day they provide interpretation in your language and call the Consumer Affairs Center with the help of the interpreter of the association.

Call the Ibaraki International Association on the day they provide interpretation in your language and ask for help from the interpreter of the association to arrange a three-way call with the Consumer Affairs Center.

\*\*Consultations at the Ibaraki International Association are only available on weekdays.

#### How to arrange a three-way call (Triophone)?

Three-way consultation.



Call a consultant at the Ibaraki International Association (029-244-3811) and ask for a three-way call with the Consumer Affairs Center.

The Ibaraki International Association consultant will call the Consumer Affairs Center and establish a three-way call.

Three-way consultation with an interpreter (interpretation is provided by the consultant of the association)



# For a consultation 1



## The person in question must contact us him or herself.

Do not panic by yourself. Contact us immediately to keep your loss at minimum.



The Consumer Affairs Center does not oversee or direct businesses in any way.

After being advised by the Consumer Affairs Center's consultant, the contractor must directly negotiate with the business. However, if a business does not respond to negotiations, the center can mediate from a neutral position to assist you in reaching a resolution.

## Explain to us your problem as concretely and accurately as possible.

- What did you buy, how much did it cost, and when and where did you buy it? (Please have any written documents such as contracts ready.)
- What is the problem and how would you like it solved?
- Is the contract a cash transaction? Do you have a receipt? Do you have any credit agreement document?



M Bring purchased items or, if you cannot bring them, have photographs ready.
